

Nick Pickering Memorial Scholarship Application

Due by Thursday of fair, July 29 2010 by 10:00am. Late entries will NOT be accepted.

If you wish to submit before fair please call Shelby Davidson at 541-350-7313 or Shannon Hall at 541-390-5369 to arrange. Feel free to contact either Shelby or Shannon at fair for any questions, submission of application or interview questions. You may hand your application to ***any member of the Alumni at the Alumni tent***. The tent is the only central place we can safely hold your application.

This application must be accompanied by the following:

A letter of recommendation. The letter cannot come from Mr. Lance Hill. You need a budget for your current project's expenses and income, and how this scholarship would figure into your budget. To be eligible you must sit for an interview with Shelby and/or Shannon. There will be sign up sheets for interviews at the Alumni tent at fair. Interviews will be available Thursday July 29 and Friday July 30 starting at 11:00 am into the afternoon both days.

This scholarship can be used for the purchase of the following:

- A livestock project
- Leadership events
- Horticulture project supplies
- Mechanics projects and supplies
- Other SAE projects

Receipts for any project must be provided before payment of scholarship funds.

If you receive this scholarship and choose to use the funds for a livestock project, that animal must be shown at next year's fair, in the FFA only. Any other projects/events must be completed in the immediately following year. If you fail to meet these requirements, or any of the others, repayment will be required back to the Nick Pickering Memorial Scholarship fund.
